A couple sits on the couch in their living room. They are Dante(30s) and Kimmie(30s).

DANTE

Snooze.

Kimmie pauses the movie.

KIMMIE

Are you trying to ruin this for me?

DANTE

No. If anything I'm trying to keep this movie from ruining you.

KIMMIE

Alright, since we can't agree on what to watch.

Kimmie turns the television off.

KIMMIE (CONT'D)

Lets just talk to each other instead.

The two sit awkwardly together in silence for a very log time.

DANTE

I think I can find something we both like.

KIMMIE

Im willing to watch anything if it keeps us from having a real conversation.

DANTE

Agreed.

KIMMIE

Thats why I love you.

DANTE

I love you too.

The two share a kiss and a sweet moment. Dante snatches up the remote as they both get comfortable.

DANTE (CONT'D)

Okay, lets see. We can't chill with anything on Netflix.

KIMMIE

Nope.

DANTE

We're maxed out on HBO.

KIMMIE

Yup.

DANTE

Amazon is passed its prime.

KIMMIE

Another pun.

DANTE

More like Disney minus.

KIMMIE

Sure.

DANTE

We don't have Hulu.

KIMMIE

Who does? Wait, whats the Depave Comedy Garden?

Dante reads the caption.

DANTE

A comedy fundraiser to support the efforts of Depave: a Portland based nonprofit. Depave works to empower disenfranchised communities to overcome social and environmental injustices and adapt to climate change through urban re-greening.

KIMMIE

Wow. How about the Depave Comedy Garden?

DANTE

Hard pass.

KIMMIE

Remember, it's either this or having a meaningful conversation.

DANTE

Depave Comedy Garden it is.

KIMMIE

And it's for a good cause. The environment.

DANTE

Ah, the good o' environment it's always there when you need it.

Kimmie presses play.

CUT TO:

INT. COMEDY SHOW - PRERECORDED

Two Host stand on stage they are Steve Dukes and Sonya Davis.

SONYA

...sadly the environment may not be there when we need it.

CUT TO:

INT. LIVING ROOM - PRESENT

DANTE

What? Wait. What? Go back. Play it from the beginning.

Kimmie rewinds to the beginning of the show.

CUT TO:

INT. COMEDY SHOW - PRERECORDED

The stage is set for a comedy show. An announcers voice booms in.

VO

Lady's and gentlemen, Steve Dukes and Sonya Davis.

The Hosts take the stage. They are Steve Dukes and Sonya Davis. The audience applause. The Hosts start their monologue.

STEVE

I'm Steve Dukes.

SONYA

And I'm Sonya Davis and welcome The 2021 Depave Comedy Garden.

Hold for applause.

STEVE

First of all, thank you for being with us this evening for The Depave Comedy Garden. This is both a celebration of Depave and it's accomplishments in the Portland community and a show of appreciation to all those who give generously of their time or money to Depave.

SONYA

So for those of you who haven't heard of Depave. The mission is simple.

To transform over-paved areas into resilient community green spaces.

STEVE

To promote workforce development and education.

SONYA

To advocate for policy changes that undo manifestations of systemic racism.

CUT TO:

INT. LIVING ROOM - NIGHT

Dante and Kimmie continue watching the presentation.

DANTE

That does not sound like a simple mission. Sounds like mission impossible.

KIMMIE

More like Mission Impaveable.

DANTE

Ha.

CUT TO:

INT. PRERECORDED SHOW - NIGHT

Steve and Sonya proceed with the presentation.

STEVE

So Why Depave?

SONY

Good question. Impervious surfaces such as Pavement and asphalt prevent rainwater from entering the soil and instead divert it to nearby waterways. This ain't good.

STEVE

Along the way, the rainwater carries pollutants like oil, antifreeze, plastics, pesticides, and heavy metals from the roads into local streams and rivers.

STEVE (CONT'D)

The run off is devastating to riparian habitat and pollutes local waterways. Local water ways supply the drinking water used to mix gatorade and thats the reason the Portland Trail Blazers didn't make it passed the second round.

SONYA

In places like Portland, Oregon, which uses combined sewer overflows, the high volume of stormwater runoff forces untreated sewage into the rivers; and I don't know about you guys but I am tired of swimming in untreated sewage. I's gross.

SONYA (CONT'D)

When have you swam in untreated sewage?

STEVE

I have a life outside our house.

SONYA

No you don't.

STEVE

Just keep going.

SONYA

Another reason to Depave is that pavement gets hot. Pavement increases the summertime temperatures in cities and suburbs. This increase in temperature is called the "heat island effect" The heat island effect which is not a sexy reality show increases temperatures in urban areas by about 10 degrees (F) higher than surrounding rural areas.

SONYA (CONT'D)

The elevated temperatures, combined with exhaust, contribute to the formation of ground-level ozone - the main constituent of smog. Another constituent of smog

CUT TO:

INT. LIVING ROOM - NIGHT

Dante and Kimmie sit on the couch.

KIMMIE

You know what else is a constituent of smog?

DANTE

Is it me?

KIMMIE

You.

DANTE

Watch the show.

DANTE (CONT'D)

(CONT'D)

SONYA

In summer 2021, Portland International Airport recorded a record high temperature of 115 degrees. Many people were without essential supplies and over 100 Portlanders even lost their lives.

STEVE

Historically redlined and lowincome neighborhoods are the most vulnerable to the negative impacts of climate change. These areas are disproportionately communities of color and most often paved environments severely lacking in green infrastructure. So why Depave?

SONYA

Because sadly the environment may not be there when we need it.

CUT TO:

INT. LIVING ROOM - NIGHT

Dante and Kimmie sit watching the show.

DANTE

So why Depave?

0.S.

Because sadly the environment may not be there when we need it.

DANTE AND KIMMIE

Oh!

CUT TO:

INT. PRERECORDED SHOW - NIGHT

Steve and Sonya continue.

STEVE

To say thank you to our constituents who have given up their time and money to help their community breathe a little better and feel a little cooler lets get to some comedy. Intro comedian:

CUT TO:

COMEDIAN SET (15 MIN)

CUT TO:

DEPAVE INTERVIEW FOOTAGE.

CUT TO:

EXT. DEPAVE SITE - DAY

A flower sits in the interview seat. This is Rosie o' Daisy.

ROSIE

I'm indigenous. Born in Portland. Im so grateful to have an organization like Depave that supports me and my community. My Dream for Depave is for it to go world wide. I hope it spreads like wildfire.

(beat)

I'm sorry thats probably offensive. I don't mean any disrespect to anyone effected by wild fires. I have two roommates who both lost their homes because of climate change. It is devastating.

CUT TO:

INT. ROSIE'S APARTMENT - DAY

Rosie enters the small apartment. She throws her keys on the coffee table, grabs a beer from the fridge and flops down on the couch. A snail slowly creeps up the side of the couch. This is Cedar.

CEDAR

Rosie. What's poppin?

ROSIE

Oh, hey Cedar. Just tryin to unwind.

CEDAR

Did you have a day?

ROSIE

I had a day.

CEDAR

Tell ya boy what happened?

ROSIE

I did an interview for Depave and I might have said something offensive. I just hope I don't get plucked.

CEDAR

Oh no! Why would you say that? Who would pluck you?

ROSIE

Well I brought up wild fires so anyone effected by wild fires could be offended. Like, you.

CEDAR

If I get offended by something you say you don't have to worry I'm not going to pluck you. I'm not unreasonable. Besides you're entitled to your opinion, and blah blah blah.

ROSIE

Thank you.

CEDAR

No problem. What did you say anyway?

ROSIE

I said, I hope Depave spreads like wild fire.

CEDAR

Thats just stupid.

ROSIE

I know. I know.

CEDAR

Welp, don't tell Fred he'll never shut up about it. He is definitely unreasonable.

Just then a frog enters. This is Fred.

FRED

Whose, unreasonable?

ROSIE

Hey Fred. We were just talking about..

CEDAR

Don't tell him.

FRED

Tell me what?

CEDAR

Nothing Fred. Just forget about it.

FRED

Well, Why don't you want me to know?

CEDAR

Because you're unreasonable. You always want to debate and we're just having a friendly talk.

FRED

I don't always want to Debate. I can talk friendly too. How are we supposed to live together if we can't have an open dialogue? Now who's being unreasonable?

ROSIE

Okay.

CEDAR

Don't tell him.

FRED

Don't be a hypocrite.

CEDAR

Fine. Go for it.

ROSIE

I said, I hope Depave spreads like wild fire in an interview to promote environmental awareness.

Fred is stunned.

FRED

You've just made a powerful enemy.

CUT TO:

INT. LIVING ROOM - DAY

Dante and Kimmie are watching the show.

DANTE

What am I watching?

KIMMIE

I love it.

CUT TO:

INT. PRERECORDED SHOW - NIGHT

The next comedian is being introduced.

STEVE

This comedian...

Comedian (12 min set)

INT. PRERECORDED SHOW - NIGHT

Steve Dukes and Sonya introduce the next comic.

STEVE

Before we introduce our final comedian we want to take a few minutes to elaborate on the question; why Depave?

SONYA

To do that we are going to play a little game called Punchline.

CUT TO:

INT. LIVING ROOM - NIGHT

Dante and Kimmie react to the program.

DANTE

This is the perfect time to go to the bathroom.

KIMMIE

The part when they explain the whole reason they exist in the first place, thats the perfect time to go to the bathroom?

DANTE

You can either pause it or just give me the recap when I get back.

KIMMIE

Whatever.

DANTE

Take lots of notes.

Dante jumps up to leave. Kimmie takes out her phone and goes down a rabbit hole.

STEVE O.C.

There are eight benefits of urban vegetation they are listed on the Depave website, Depave.org. We are taking those 8 benefits and we are going to play a game called Punchline.

Kimmie googles Depave.

INT. PRERECORDED SHOW - NIGHT

Steve and Sonya play Punchline.

SONYA

This is how we play Punchline. It's a two person game so feel free to play later with your mom or someone waiting in the line outside Trader Joes with you. One person gives a set up and the other person lands the punchline. For example, Steve would you like to play punchline.

STEVE

You damn right I would.

SONYA

Great I'll set you up and you knock em down.

STEVE

Go for it.

SONYA

Mayonnaise is a far better treat than I expected.

STEVE

So I put a bunch in the bathtub and left momma in there through the weekend.

SONYA

Just like that.

CUT TO:

INT. LIVING ROOM - NIGHT

Kimmie is looking at the Why Depave menu.

STEVE O.C.

Okay, so we each get four set ups. All benefits of urban vegetation from depave.org. You're first. You ready?

SONYA O.C.

Ready.

INT. PRERECORDED SHOW - NIGHT

Steve and Sonya play Punchline.

STEVE

Cooling of homes and offices by shading the sun's rays and the protection against harsh winds.

SONYA

And thank god I don't have to keep wearing my bikini at the office.

STEVE

Ambient cooling from evapotranspiration of rain on the leaves.

SONYA

Reducing the urine smell by 40 percent. Thanks Depave.

CUT TO:

INT. LIVING ROOM - NIGHT

Kimmie scrolls through the Depave site. She highlights "Heat Island Effect" (or types Heat island into Google).

STEVE O.C.

Aesthetic enhancement to areas and psychosocial benefits associated with greenery.

SONYA O.C.

I got a new attitude. My flowerbeds got a new attitude. My vegetable gardens got a new attitude.

Kimmie scrolls through an article.

STEVE O.C.

Alright, Settle down. Enhancing air quality by removing particulate pollutants and carbon dioxide from the air while producing oxygen.

CUT TO:

INT. PRERECORDED SHOW - NIGHT

Sonya answers the set up.

SONYA

Im high off life. I blow through
02.

STEVE

Okay. My turn.

SONYA

You ready?

STEVE

Ready.

SONYA

Visual privacy and reduction of noise from the street.

STEVE

So naked parties in my yard are neither seen nor heard by the general public.

SONYA

Traffic calming when trees are planted along urban streets.

STEVE

Reducing road rage enough for me to get through Burgerville drive through.

CUT TO:

INT. LIVING ROOM - NIGHT

Kimmie scrolls through another article about heat island.

SONYA O.C.

Restoration of local habitat for birds, insects and other wildlife.

STEVE O.C.

My back yard is an ecosystem, I am a apex predator and thats why I keep pissing in the neighbors bushes.

SONYA O.C.

Thats the reason huh?

STEVE O.C.

Yup.

Kimmie begins typing heat island into google one last time. As she types "Hot Islander" displays as one of the suggestions. She hesitates for a second and then clicks on it.

CUT TO:

INT. PRERECORDED SHOW - NIGHT

Sonya gives the final set up.

SONYA

Okay last one. If the previouslypaved land is used for farming, this provides food and nutrition for local residents.

STEVE O.C.

Im growing all this weed in my backyard for nutritional reasons.

SONYA

And thats Punchline ladies and gentlemen.

CUT TO:

INT. LIVING ROOM - NIGHT

Kimmie is looking at pictures of Hot islanders. Dante walks in.

DANTE

That does not look like notes about Depave.

CUT TO:

INT. PRERECORDED SHOW - NIGHT

Steve introduces the last comedian.

STEVE

Coming to the stage next...

COMEDIAN SET 1-15 COMEDY SET

INT. PRERECORDED SHOW - NIGHT

Steve Sonya and the comedian give a farewell.

STEVE

Thats it for this years Comedy garden. We want to give a big thank you to our guests tonight Jake Silberman, Jeron George and Tori Ward.

SONYA

Thank you to our donors, volunteers, sponsors and everyone responsible for making Depave possible.

CUT TO:

INT. LIVING ROOM - NIGHT

Dante and Kimmie watch the rest of the show.

STEVE O.C.

Have a wonderful night everyone.

The ending music plays as Dante cuts off the T.v.

KIMMIE

That didn't completely suck.

DANTE

It didn't. I think I laughed like four times. No five. No six. Okay I think Im gonna go to bed.

KIMMIE

I'll be in, in a second.

DANTE

Okay

Dante leaves the room. After Dante leaves Kimmie picks up her phone again. She reopens the Hot islander page. Kimmie closes the page and goes back to the Depave website she clicks on the volunteer tab.
